**Тема уроку: «Traditional UK cuisine. Types of food establishments and criteria for their evaluation.»**

**Мета уроку:** Активізація нової лексики. Вдосконалювати навички усного мовлення та письма. Розвивати культуру спілкування та мовленнєву реакцію учнів.

**Матеріали уроку:**

Cuisine - кухня, lamb – ягня, pork - свинина, beef – яловичина, cereal - вівсяні пластівці, porridge - вівсяна каша, ginger – імбир, gravy – м'ясна підлива, pea – горох, mustard – гірчиця, a speciality – спеціальний асортимент; to be thirsty – хотіти пити, to be hungry- бути голодним, to lay the table – накривати на стіл, to fry – смажити, to stew – тушкувати, to serve – подавати, to bake – пекти, to cut – різати.

## British Meals

Traditionally English people have three meals a day: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Breakfast is served in the morning. It used to be a large meal with cereal, eggs and bacon, sausages, tomatoes. But such a large breakfast takes a long time to prepare is not very healthy. Nowadays, Britain's most popular breakfast consists of cereal, toast with marmalade, juice and yogurt with a cup of tea or coffee.

Lunch is a light meal. Most people have no time to go back home for lunch so they eat at school, cafes, pubs or restaurants.

The main meal is dinner, which is usually between 6 and 7 p.m. A typical evening meal is a meat dish with vegetables and dessert.

The most important meal of the week is the Sunday dinner, which is usually eaten at 1 p.m. The traditional Sunday dish used to be roast beef, but nowadays pork, chicken or lamb are more common.

On Sunday evenings people have supper or high tea. The famous British afternoon tea is becoming rare, except at weekends.

**Waiter:** Welcome to our restaurant. Here are your menus. I'll be back to take your order in a few minutes.

**Waiter (in a few minutes):** Are you ready to order?

**Customer:** I'll have the fried potato.

**Waiter:** Would you like anything to drink?

**Customer:** I'll have tea.

**Waiter:** Would you like anything else?

**Customer:** Yes, please. I would like some boiled vegetables.

**Waiter:** Would you like any dessert?

**Customer:** No, thank you. How long will it take?

**Waiter:** It will take about 15 minutes.

Could you bring the menu, please? – Не могли б Ви принести меню, будь ласка?

Could I see the wine list, please? – Я можу побачити карту вин, будь

ласка?

Are you ready to order? – Ви готові зробити замовлення?

I am not ready yet. – Я ще не готовий.

What do you recommend? – Що Ви порекомендуєте?

I would like the set lunch. – Я б хотів комплексний обід.

I will take this. – Я візьму це.

Does it contain ...? – В цю страву входить...?

What specials do you have? – Які особливі блюда у вас є?

For here or to go? – Тут чи з собою?

Would you like anything else? – Бажаєте ще щось?

Nothing else, thank you – Більше нічого, дякую.

How long will it take? – Скільки часу це займе?

Would you like any coffee or dessert? – Ви бажаєте каву чи десерт?

Could you bring us some more bread/ milk/ water? – Не могли б Ви нам принести ще хліба/ молока/ води?

### **Dialogue 3.**

**Customer: Excuse me! My meal is too salty. Could you take care of it, please?**

**Waiter: Excuse me. I'll change it right now.**

**\*2 hours later\***

**Customer: Thank you. Now it is ok.**

This food is cold. – Їжа холодна.

This dish is too salty. – Ця страва пересолена.

We've been waiting a long time. – Ми чекаємо вже давно.

Can I see the manager, please? – Я можу побачити адміністратора?

This meat is underdone/over roasted. – Це м'ясо недосмажене/пересмажене.

This dish is not cooked enough – Ця страва недоготовлена.

On the house. – За рахунок закладу.

### **Dialogue 4.**

**Waiter: May I take away the dishes?**

**Customer: Yes, please. And could you bring us the bill?**

**Waiter: Yes, of course. How would you like to pay: in cash or by credit card?**

**Customer: By credit card. Here you go.**

**Waiter: Ok. Here is your bill.**

**Customer: Thank you. Is the service included?**

**Waiter: Yes, it is. Have a good day!**

Can I pay by card? – Я можу оплатити картою?

Do you take credit cards? – Ви берете кредитку?

Is service included in bill? – Плата за обслуговування входить в рахунок?

Can we pay separately? – Можемо ми заплатити окремо?

Keep the change. – Решту залиште собі.
